AHSDC Club Permit Declaration Form - 2019

NOTE: If you have a Club Permit Car with the AHSDC you also need to sign this form! The AHSDC allows all "Sprites", "Midgets", "Innocenti" and "Frogeye Sprites" as detailed in the club constitution to be placed on the club permit system so long as the car is 25 years or older. AHSDC members with associate cars will be allowed on the scheme if they already own one or more of the above Spridget based vehicles. This form is in addition to the VICROADS Permit form and is for the AHSDC to keep its own records and help administer the Club Permit Scheme.

As part of the Club plate permit scheme, participants need to read and acknowledge the following by signing below:-

- The Club permit scheme administered by the AHSDC is only open to financial members of the AHSDC. Once members resign or let their membership lapse the permit will be deemed to have ceased. Membership is deemed to have lapsed as of the 1st January in the following new year.

- The Club Permit scheme is not "Registration for old cars" or for that matter registration of the vehicle; it is a permit for the restricted use of an unregistered vehicle for which the appropriate Transport Accident Charge and Permit Fee have been paid. The permit scheme consists of a log book scheme for which the holder or the authorised driver will fill out the log book at the start of the day on which the vehicle is to be used. Log books will not be required to be filled out if the vehicle travels less than 100 metres from its garaged address. Once the log book has been filled out the vehicle may be used for any purpose, club event or not.

- Of important note is the fact that it is a VICROADS requirement that all vehicles participating on the scheme must be in a safe working condition. If a vehicle will not pass a roadworthy certificate then it is deemed not safe to use. The onus of vehicle safety is totally with the Club Permit holder/driver. If the AHSDC becomes aware that a vehicle is being driven in an unsafe or unroadworthy condition, then the Club is obliged to promptly notify that member of the suspected safety issue(s) and require that any such issues be rectified within 14 days. Full details and requirements of the scheme can be found at the VICROADS website.

A permit will not be issued or re-signed by the club unless this form is signed by the applicant at the start of each financial year, or, on joining the AHSDC/applying for a permit.

On ceasing membership of the club, the club permit signed by the AHSDC will be deemed to be void and any such car driven on the road will be in breach of Victorian and interstate motor registration rules.
